## Planting Bulbs

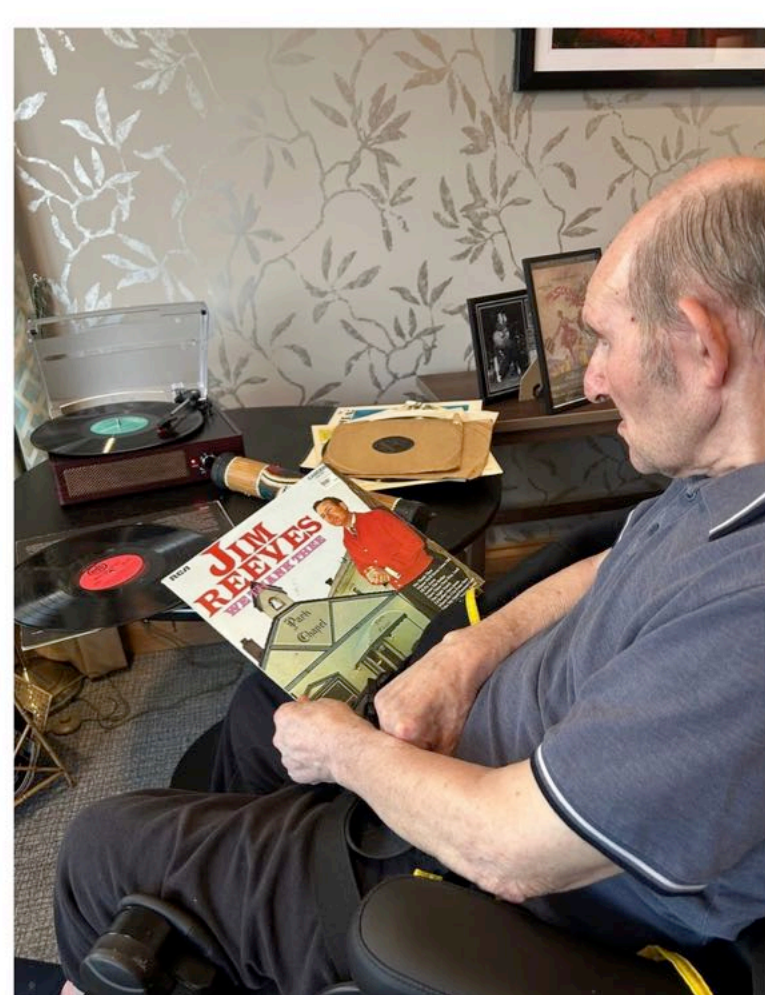
Heading into winter the residents made sure our planters were planted ready for the spring, thank you to our wonderful relatives for their assistance.

## Sensory and Reminiscing Room

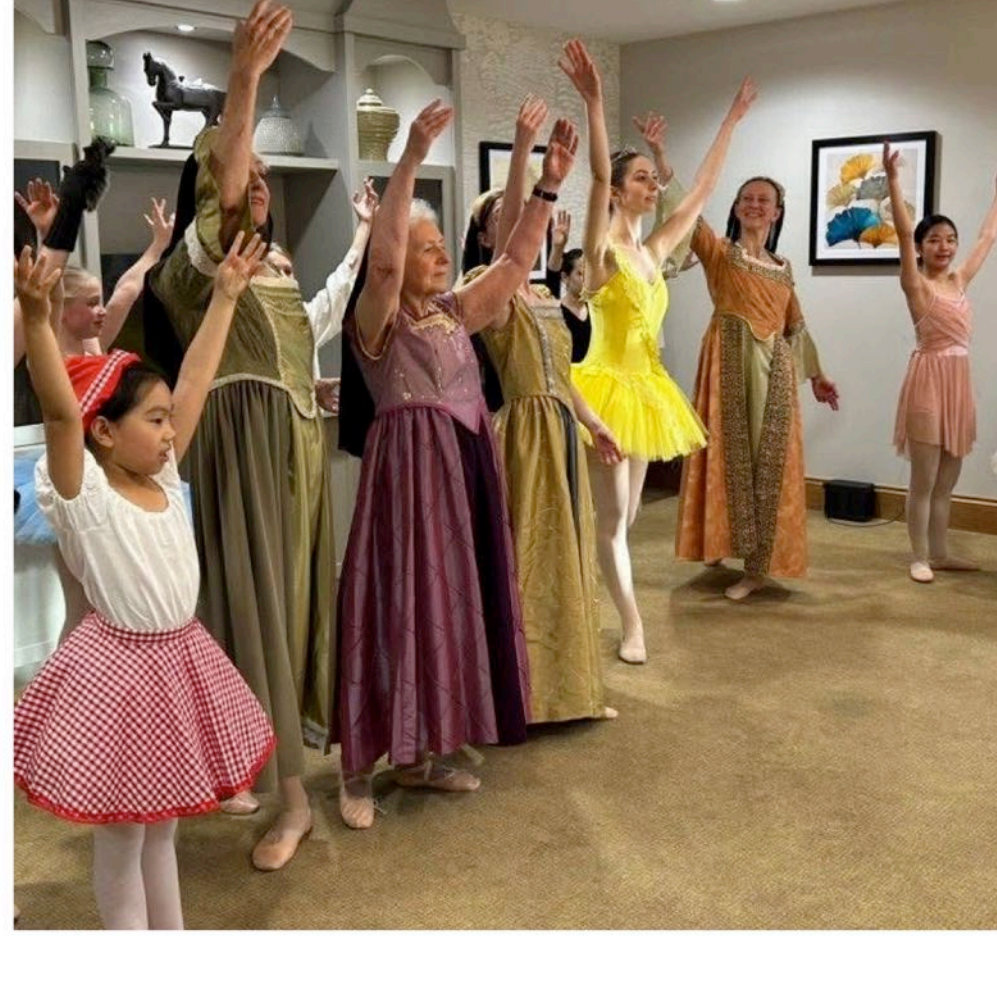

## Christmas Fayre Fundraiser

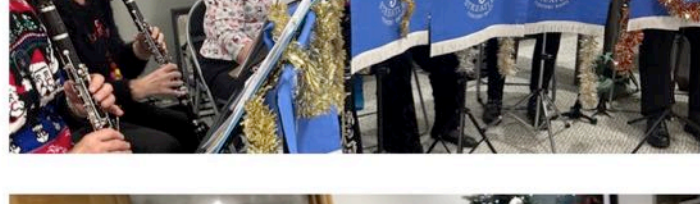
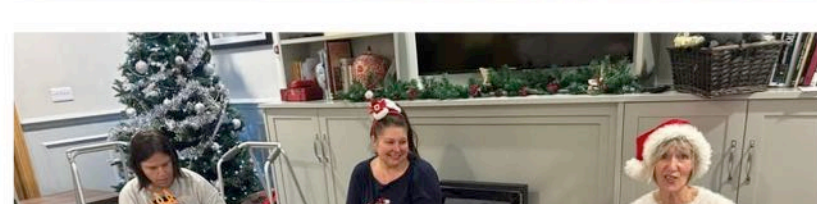
